

INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATES

**APPEARING IN THE RECRUITMENT OF JUNIOR ENGINEER (CIVIL/ELECTRICAL/MECHANICAL)
EXAMINATION, PWD MANIPUR ON 25-02-2024 (Sunday) FROM 1:00 PM TO 3:00 PM**

AT DM COLLEGE OF SCIENCE/ARTS/COMMERCE, DHANAMANJURI UNIVERSITY, IMPHAL.

1. Candidates must reach the examination center 1 (one) hour before the start of the examination.
2. Candidates are required to bring their Admit Card, pen, basic calculator (non-programmable). In addition to the Admit Card, the candidate may also be required to produce his government identity card (Aadhaar/Pan Card/Driving License/Passport). The candidate should, therefore, keep his government identity card also available for production if required by the Invigilator.
3. No candidate will be permitted to enter the Examination Hall later than 15 minutes after the start of the examination, that is candidates can enter the hall up-to 1:15 PM and is not allowed to depart before the examination ends, that is candidates can leave the hall only after 3:00 PM.
4. Candidates found taking recourse to any unfair means in the examination hall shall render themselves liable to expulsion at the discretion of the invigilator and may be debarred from taking the rest of the examination.
5. Use and possession of any electronic devices like smart watches, mobile phones, Bluetooth devices, pager etc. are strictly prohibited. Any candidate found in possession of the above devices, the candidature for the examination will be cancelled. However, use of basic calculator is allowed.
6. No candidate will be permitted to take away question paper cum answer book from the examination hall.
7. There shall be 100 multiple choice questions (General English, General Knowledge and Subject Specific) which are to be answered in the allotted time of 2 (two) hours.
8. Each question consists of four choices, out of which one choice is correct. Select the correct choice in each question and darken the circle given against the option.
9. For each correct answer 2 marks will be awarded and for each wrong answer 1 mark will be deducted. There will be no award or deduction for un-attempted questions.
10. If a candidate gives more than one response or overwrites, it will be treated as a wrong response.
11. Use of only Blue or Black ink ballpoint is permitted.
12. For rough calculation (s), use the blank pages provided in the booklets.
